The Jacquemart-André Museum contains collections worthy of the greatest museums: works from the Italian Renaissance, works by great Flemish masters, French works from the 18th century. (Meet tour guide at the Museum for 1:30 pm; 20 spots available – 2 hours).

Guided tour of the Orangerie Museum: The **Musée de l'Orangerie** is an art gallery of Impressionist and Post-Impressionist paintings located in the west corner of the Tuileries Garden next to the Place de la Concorde in Paris (Meet tour guide at the Museum for 1:30 pm; 20 spots available, 2 hours).
